Being at school on time ensures students can prepare for the day and be ready to embark on learning with their peers, rather than trying to catch up. It sets the tone for the day and provides an opportunity for students to catch up with their friends before class, often reducing the possibility of disruptions during class. Being on time also helps students learn about routine and commitment which are important life skills. Please encourage your child/children to wear their uniform to school proudly each day. We will again be rewarding classes which have the most students in uniform with an extra play every few weeks.

## **IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICE**




