KINDY & PRE PRIMARY ENROLMENTS FOR 2019

Applications for enrolment of students entering Kindergarten and Pre Primary in 2019 are now being taken.

Children entering Kindergarten must have a date of birth between 1 July 2014 and 30 June 2015. Children entering Pre Primary must have a date of birth between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014.

The school Education Act of 1999 requires parents/guardians to provide their child's immunisation records when the child is enrolled in school. The Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) Immunisation History Statement is also a requirement of the Department of Education Student Health Care Policy.

Parents are therefore asked to obtain a current copy of the immunisation details by:

- Phoning the ACIR on 1800 653 809
- Emailing: acir@humanservices.gov.au
- Visiting your local Medicare centre (Department of Human Services Centre) and requesting an ACIR history statement
- Registering with the Department of Human Services online at: http://www.humanservices.gov.au/ onlineservices
