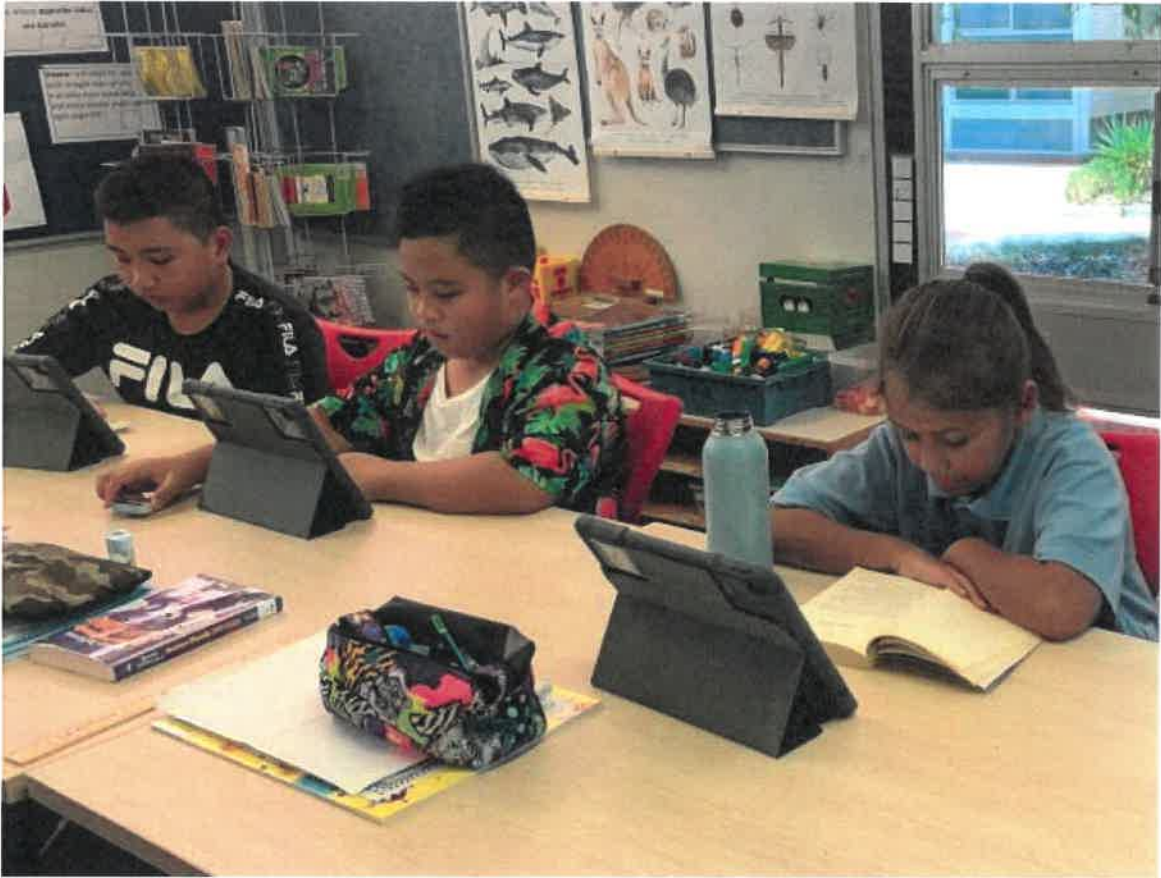
KINDERGARTEN 2023
